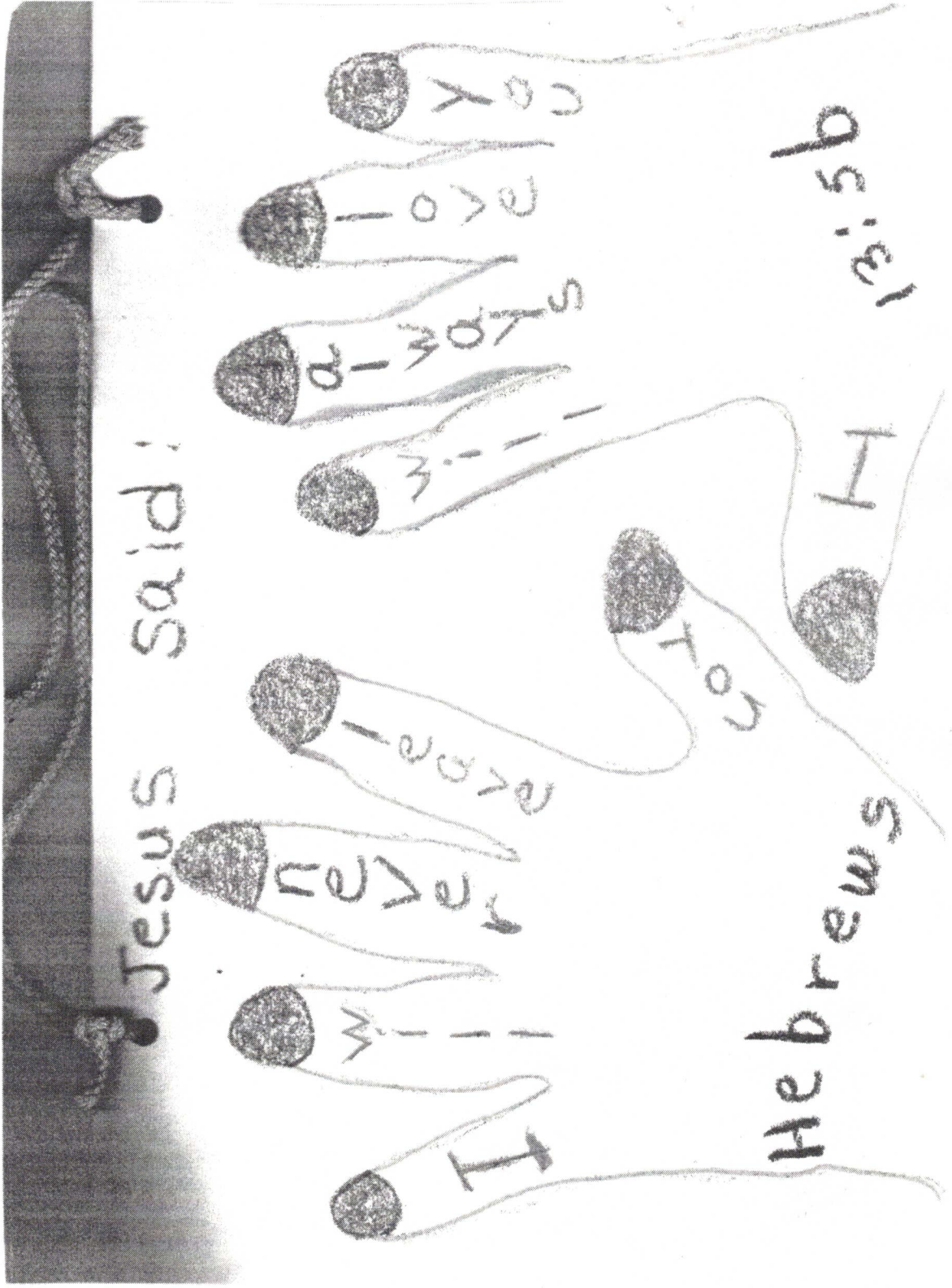

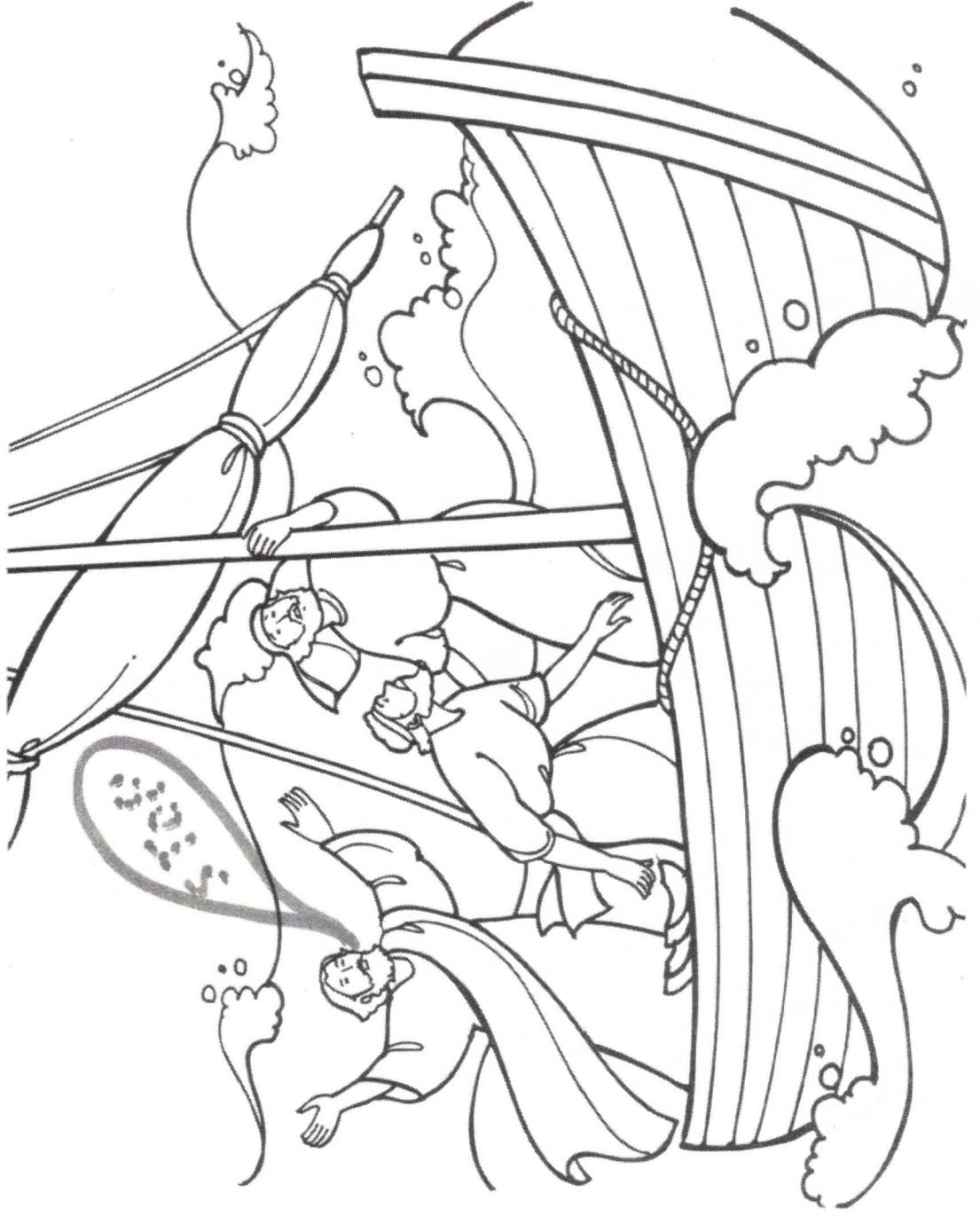

The disciples were afraid they would sink. Do you ever get afraid of anything? When you are afraid or doubting or worried, that is a storm in your life. Write a short paragraph about a storm in your life. Use one or two sentences to tell about the storm. Use one or two sentences to tell how you felt in the storm. Use two sentences to tell about where your help came from. Then tell whether or not you had faith in Jesus in the storm. This is worth four points if done well.

Here is a sample from Sharon's life: *I had a storm in my life on October 3, 1980. My little brother Chris, who was only 6 years old, died. I felt very sad because I missed being with him. Many Christians prayed for our family and that helped. Jesus helped the most by my remembering His promises that when we die, if we believe in Him, we go to Heaven. I know that someday I'll play with Chris again, in a better place, heaven. Chris's favorite song was, "Jesus, I believe in you!" Do you believe in Him too? I do.*
