### David is Eleven

This is a true story. It was told by the doctor's wife. The doctor of a small West Virginia community stands as the town's lone symbol of defense against disease and death. He sees patients all day, often works at night, and has built a small hospital---the only one for miles around.

At the dinner table one evening, the doctor was unusually quiet; his face wore an unfamiliar frown and strain of anxiety. Said his wife, "Come on, dear, let's get it out in the open."

That surprised me, “Why not?”

### Sharon's Testimony

*Different people come to believe in Jesus in different ways. For me it was like this. I grew up in a Christian home and knew all about Christ. When I was 9 or 10, I began to feel fidgety during worship when the pastor called people to the altar to ask Jesus to be their savior. I began thinking about Christ and whether or not I really wanted Him to be the lord of my life. I asked my mom about going forward to the altar on a Sunday and "receiving Christ as my savior." "How old should I be?" I asked her.*

*"Oh, when the Holy Spirit speaks to you, you will know it!" was her answer.*

*I was in a public school in which a third of my class was Jewish. They would leave school for half of each Friday to learn Hebrew! I was very aware that other students believed differently than the people in my home. We studied Buddhist, Muslim and Jewish belief systems that year in school. I began to be troubled. I doubted if Jesus was true. I would say to myself, "What if I give my life to Jesus and then I find out that Christianity is not true, or maybe there is not a god, or maybe the Buddhists are right in what they believe." I studied my Bible and I prayed about my doubts. One night in my bedroom, I prayed and told Jesus that I was sorry for my sins. I asked Him to come and live in my life and be my lord. "But please, Jesus, let's just not make this public. I will belong to You, but I do not want to go forward in church. All those people would stare at me."*

*In a few weeks, we had a Revival Service. Dr. Munson came to preach. The Holy Spirit was speaking to me! I decided to give in and really show everyone that I belonged to Jesus. I wanted to go to the front of the church and say it. There was a big problem. There were seven people in the pew on my left and one huge woman on my right. She held her book up high and sang loudly. I was stuck. I was crying for joy, but I couldn't get out of the pew! So in desperation, I climbed up over the pew and jumped into the aisle. The next Sunday, I was baptized by triune immersion. Jesus is still my Savior and my Lord. He has first place in my life.*
