
Kindergarteners: The power in this story is that we all mess up.

Both parents and both twins sinned in this story.

If kids think adults are perfect, it is hard for them to identify sin in their own lives. If we readily say, "Oh,

Steven I sinned when I yelled so loudly, will you forgive Mommy?" our kids will begin to recognize sin in their own lives and be able to ask for forgiveness from others and from God.

I insist on the sentence: "Will you forgive me for biting you? Or hitting you? Or kicking you?" naming the sin rather than "I'm sorry!" by the time kids are 4 years old.


