









Preschool: Color the cards, and then cut them out. Put the verse together in one long stretch using tape or glue.

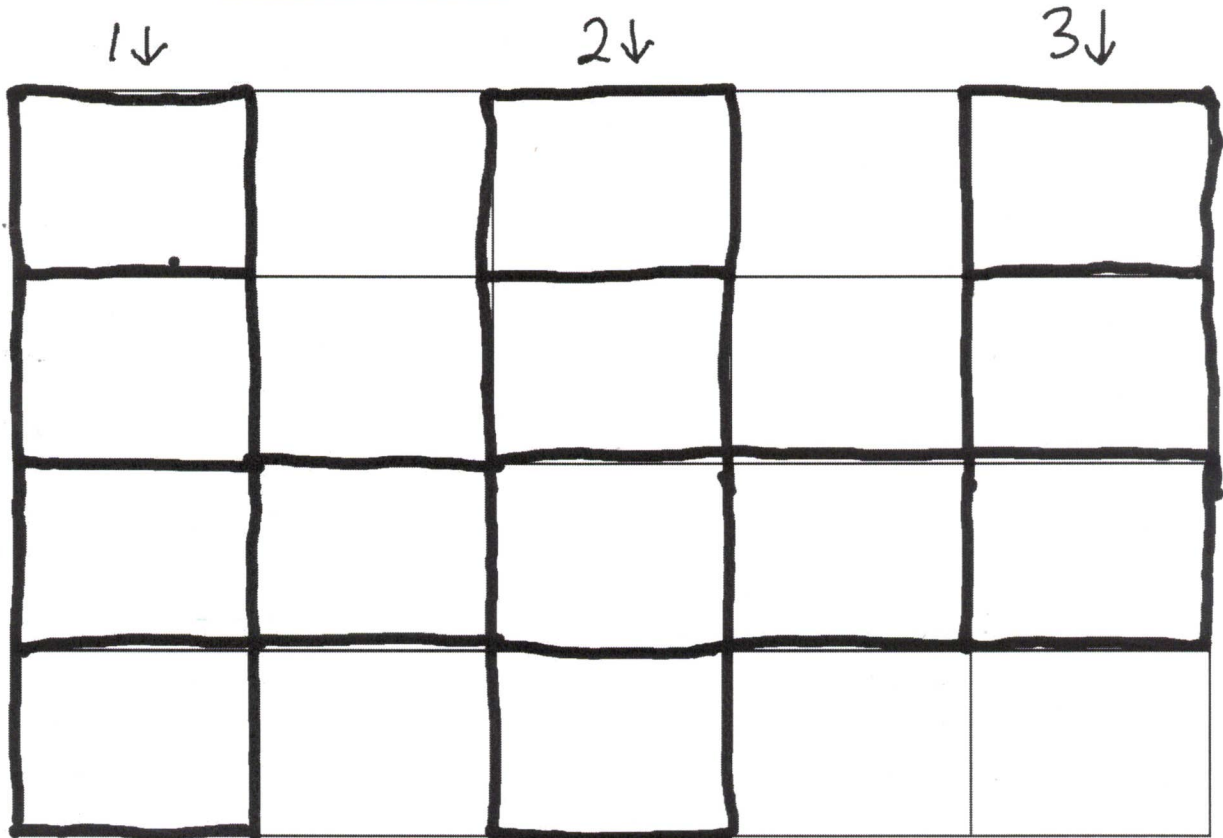

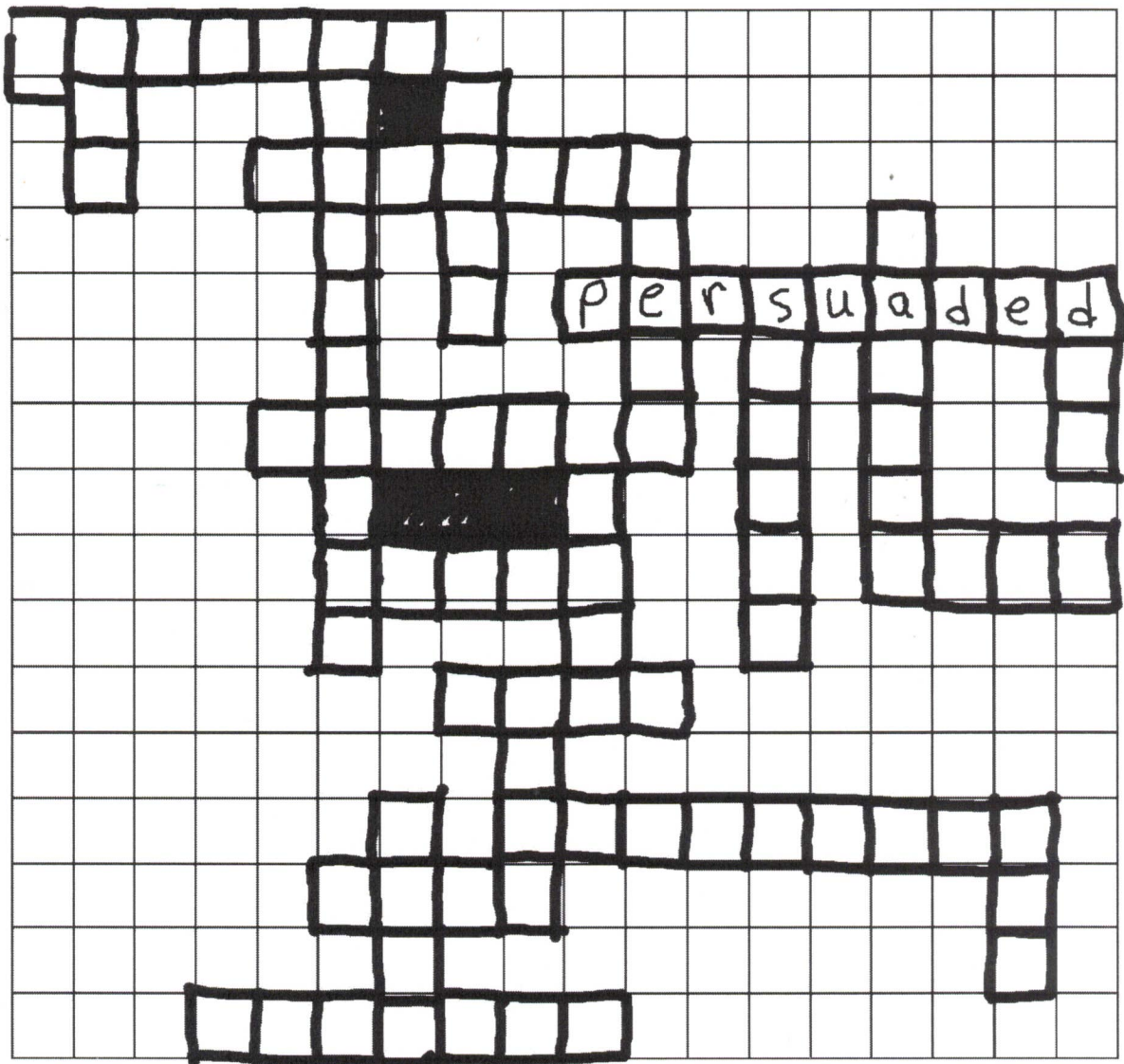
